Before moving to Colorado, Evan worked as a Junior Designer and Historic Preservation Specialist with Historic Building Architects in Trenton, New Jersey. While an undergrad, Evan focused on Architectural History within the HAA department, writing his thesis on the century-long evolution of the design of the Cathedral of Saint John the Divine in New York City. He went on to attain a Master of Science in Historic Preservation from the University of Pennsylvania School of Design where he focused on Preservation Planning and Design. His masters thesis centered on the preservation and interpretation of sites of negative heritage.
