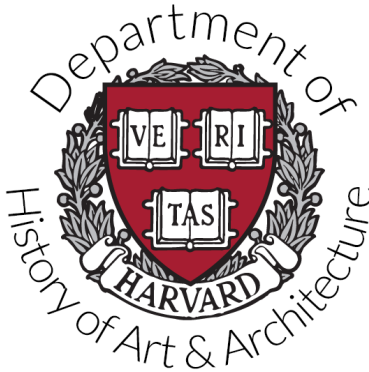

Molly (Dorkin) Taylor (HAA Class of '03) completed her AB in History of Art at Harvard University, and attended the Courtauld Institute where she received her MA with a focus in Italian Renaissance Art. Molly then spent several years as a Specialist in Old Master Paintings at Christie's in New York before returning to academia, earning her PhD in British 18th century art at Magdalene College, Cambridge.
