How to Convert .avi Videos for use in PowerPoint on a Windows System

To convert .avi video files to a format readable by PowerPoint on a Windows system you will need to download and install Prism Video Converter. In addition to Prism Video Converter, the computer will also need to have VLC media player installed.

NOTE: If Prism Video Converter and VLC media player are already installed please proceed to the section "Converting videos".

Installation of Prism Video Converter and VLC media player

Once both applications have been downloaded, run each installer and follow the default prompts. At the end of each installation a shortcut to the application will be placed on your desktop.

Converting videos

- 1. Launch the **Prism Video Converter** application.
- 2. Click on the **Add File(s)** button.
- 3. Navigate to the .avi file you want to convert, select it and click **Open**.
- 4. The default **Output Folder** will be "My Documents\My Videos". If you want to save the video in a different location click on the **Browse...** button, navigate to the desired location and click **OK**.
- 5. Under Output Format select the option ".wmv".
- 6. Click on the **Convert** button to begin the conversion process.
- 7. Once the file has been successfully converted a check mark will appear next to the video's title in the Prism Video Convert window.

The video is now ready to be inserted into a PowerPoint presentation.
