HOW TO EXTRACT IMAGES FROM A PDF WITH ADOBE ACROBAT PRO

Extracting a single page as an image from a multi-page PDF

- 1. Open the PDF in **Adobe Acrobat Pro**.
- 2. Make sure "Page Thumbnails" are displaying. If "Page Thumbnails" is not showing, go to the **View** menu, select **Show/Hide**, select **Navigation Panes** and then choose **Page Thumbnails**.
- 3. Under the **Page Thumbnails** section, select the page to be extracted, right-click (or control-click on the Mac), and select **Extract Pages**.
- 4. In the Extract Pages window, check the box "Extract Pages As Separate Files" and click OK.
- 5. Select the location to save the page and click **Choose**.
- 6. Open the newly extracted page in **Adobe Acrobat Pro**.
- 7. Go to the **File** menu and select **Save As**.
- 8. In the "Save As:" field, enter in a new filename.
- 9. Under the "Format" dropdown menu select JPEG.
- 10. Click on the **Settings...** button, change both the "Grayscale" and "Color" settings to **JPEG (Quality : Maximum)** and click **OK**.
- 11. Click Save.
- 12. Once the image has been saved, open it in any image editing software and crop as needed.

Extracting multiple pages as images from a multi-page PDF

NOTE: When extracting multiple images from a multi-page PDF, Adobe Acrobat Pro will save every page of the document, whether you want them or not, as an individual files. Unfortunately, there is no way to select a range or a grouping of pages.

- 1. Open the PDF in **Adobe Acrobat Pro**.
- 2. Go to the **File** menu and select **Save As**.
- 3. In the "Save As:" field, enter in a new filename.
- 4. Under the "Format" dropdown menu select **JPEG.**
- 5. Click on the **Settings...** button, change both the "Grayscale" and "Color" settings to **JPEG (Quality : Maximum)** and click **OK**.
- 6. Click on the **New Folder** button, enter in a folder name and click **Create**.

- 7. Click Save.
- 8. Once the pages have been extracted, open the page(s) containing the images of interest in any image editing software and crop as needed.
- 9. Discard any unnecessary pages that were extracted from the PDF.
