HOW TO EXTRACT IMAGES FROM A PDF WITH PREVIEW

- 1. Open the PDF in **Preview**.
- 2. Make sure the "Sidebar" is displayed and the "Thumbnail" view has been selected. If the "Sidebar" is not displaying, go to the **View** menu and select **Thumbnails**.
- 3. In the "Sidebar" click on the page to be saved as a jpeg, go to the **File** menu and select **Export As...** (or **Export...**).
- 4. In the "Export As:" field, enter in a unique filename.
- 5. In the "Where:" dropdown menu select the location to save the extracted page.
- 6. Change the "Format" dropdown menu to **JPEG** and move the "Quality" slider to **Best**.
- 7. Click Save.
- 8. Once the image has been saved, open it up again in preview and crop as needed.
- 9. Repeat process for additional pages.
