## **Qualifying Paper Proposal**

The Qualifying Paper proposal should be submitted to the department by the beginning of the 4<sup>th</sup> term of residence. It should include the proposed topic, timetable for preparation, and suggested committee (selected through mutual agreement of the student, field adviser and DGS) for approval by the faculty. To maintain satisfactory status in the graduate program, the completed and approved Qualifying Paper (with signed QP cover form) should be filed in the department office not later than the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> term of residence. Exceptions to this policy will be discouraged.

Following completion of the Qualifying Paper, the student will discuss with the main field adviser their overall performance and general status in the department. This assessment will determine whether or not a student is recommended to continue as a candidate for the Ph.D. degree.
