Recommended GSD Courses - spring 2024

The GSD's courses are evaluated on a pass/fail scale by default. If you plan to use a GSD course towards the concentration, you must request an FAS letter grade from the instructor at the start of the term, as well as formally request this via a change of grading basis petition in my.harvard. **Failure to take these steps by the start of the fifth Monday of term will disallow you from counting the course towards concentration requirements.
